Звук - самолета -1 слайд

Звук – птицы- 2 слайд

Act 1, Scene One.

Piggy

Hi, wait a minute. Wait a minute. I can't hardly move with all these creeper things. Where's the man with the megaphone?

Ralf

This is an island. At least I think it's an island. That's a reef out in the sea. Perhaps there aren't any grown-ups anywhere.

Piggy

All other kids, some of them must have got out. They must have, mustn't they? Aren't there any grown - ups at all?

Ralf

I don't think so.

Piggy

No grown - ups?

Piggy

What about the pilot?

Ralf

He must have flown off after he dropped us. He couldn't land here. Not in a plane with wheels.

Piggy

Were we attacked?

Ralf

He'll be back, all right.

Piggy

No, when we were coming down I looked through one of the windows. I saw the other part of the plane. There were flames coming out of it....What's your name?

Ralf

Ralf....

Piggy

I expect there's a lot more of us scatted about. You haven't seen any others, have you?...

Piggy

My auntie told me not to run, on account of my asthma.

Ralf

Ass-mar?

Piggy

That's right. Can't catch my breath. I was the only boy in our school who had asthma, and I've been wearing specs since I was three.... There! I expect we'll want to know all their names and make a list. We ought to have a meeting.

I don't care what they call me, so long as they don't call me what they used to call me at school.



Ralf

What was that?

Piggy

They used to call me "Piggy"

Ralf

Piggy, Piggy, Piggy.

Piggy

Ralf, please!...So long as you don't tell others....

(coming to water, Piggy took off his shoes and socks< ranged them carefully on the ledge, tested the water with one toe)

Piggy

It's hot.

Ralf

What did you expect?

Piggy

My auntie told me..

Ralf

Sucks to your auntie. Aren't you going to swim?

Piggy

I can't swim. I wasn't allowed. My asthma...

Ralf

Sucks to your asthma.... I could swim when I was 5. Daddy taught me. He's a commander in the Navy. When he gets leave he'll come and rescue us. What's your father?

Piggy

My dad's dead. And my Mum... I used to live with my auntie. She kept a sweet shop. I used to eat so many sweets. As many as I liked. When'll your Daddy rescue us?

Ralf

Soon as he can.

Piggy

How does he know we are here?...

How does he know we are here?...

Ralf

Because,... Because,...Because,...

They would tell him at the airport.

Piggy

Not them. Didn't you hear what the pilot said? About the atom bomb. They are all dead. (Ralf stood up considering the unusual problem).

Your dad doesn't know, nobody knows. We may stay here till we die. We got to do something.

Piggy

What's that! It's a shell! Careful , you'll break it.

Piggy

You try Ralf. You'll call the others.

Piggy

There's one!

(A child appeared, Ralf continued to blow. Three small children appeared. A group of boys headed by a leader marched).

Jack.

Where is the man with the trumpet?

Ralf

There is no man with the trumpet. Only me.

Jack.

Aren't there any grown-ups? We'll have to look after ourselves, then.

Piggy

That's why Ralf made a meeting. So we can decide what to do.

Jack

You are talking too much. Shut up, Fatty.

We've got to decide about being rescued.

Ralf

Seems to me we ought to have a chief. A chief. A chief.

Jack

I ought to be a chief. I am the head boy.

Another boy.

Let's vote then.

Ralf

Well, who wants Jack for a chief? Who wants me? I'm the chief then.
(The boys applauded).

Act2. Scene 1.

Fire on the mountain.

Ralf.

Well, then. We're on the island. We've been on the mountain top. We saw no houses, no smoke, no boats, no people.

Jack.

All the same. We need an army. For hunting. Hunting pigs.

Another boy.

There aren't grown-ups. We shall have to look after ourselves.

Ralf.

And another thing. We can't have everybody talking at once. We'll have to have "Hands up" like at school. Then I'll give him the conch.

And he won't be interrupted except me.

Piggy

Nobody knows where we are.

The plane was shot in flames. Nobody knows where we are.

We maybe here a long time.

But this is a good island. There's food, drink and.. rocks, blue flowers.

While we are waiting we can have a good time on the island.

It's like in the book.

A small boy.

But there is a beastie. (going to cry)

Where ?

In the wood.

He must have had a night mare.

Ralf.

Shut up. Wait. Listen.

There is another thing. We can help them find us.
If a ship comes near the island they may not notice us. So we must make smoke on the top of the mountain. We must make a fire.
Come on. Follow me. Let's make a fire.
Has anyone got matches?
Piggy? Have you got any matches?
His specs. Use them as burning glasses.
Piggy.
Here. Let me go. Mind out. Give them back. I can hardly see. My specs. Give me my specs.

Звук костра – 6 слайд – коряга

Boys are dancing around the fire.
More wood.
All of you get more wood.
Piggy.
I got the conch. You let me speak.
Jack.
Shut up. The conch doesn't matter on the mountain.
Piggy.
I got the conch. You let me speak.
I agree with Ralf. We have got to have rules, we are English. And the English are the best at everything. So we have got to do the right things.
(Крик: Snakes , snakes. All run away.)

Звук –гудки корабля – 6 слайд- корабль (4 раза)

Act3. Scene 1

(a boy stays on the beach. He sees a ship's smoke and a whistle)

Smoke, smoke!

I can't see any smoke. Ralph, where is it?

They will see our smoke on the mountain.

Piggy

I know I can't see much , but there is no smoke on the mountain.

(the boys run to the mountain fire)

Oh God, oh God! The fire is dead.

(look at the sea)

Come back, come back.

They let the bloody fire out.

There they are.

(Jack is appearing with his group)

'Kill the pig. Cut her throat. Spill her blood.'

Jack

Look we have killed a pig.

Ralph

You let the fire out.

Jack

We can light the fire again.

You should have been with us , Ralph. We had a smashing time.

(the boys dance and sing).

We'll go hunting every day.

Ralph

You let the fire out.

Jack

We needed the boys in the hunt. Or there wouldn't be enough boys for a ring.

The fire has been out only for an hour or two.

Ralph

There was a ship. There was a ship. Out there. You said you would keep the fire going and you let it out.

They might have seen us. We might have gone home.

Ralph

I was a chief, and you were going to do what I said. You only talk. You can't even build huts. Then you go off hunting. And let the fire out.

There was a ship.

Jack.

The job was too much. We needed everyone.

We needed meat.

(Jack is holding a knife and transfers it in from hand to hand).

Piggy

You didn't ought to have let the fire out. You said you would keep the smoke going.

(a boy pushes piggy)

Piggy

My specs. One side is broken.

Now I 've got only one eye. Just you wait...

Just you wait... Just you wait...

(all laugh).

Ralph

All right, all right.

Jack.

I'm sorry about the fire. I apologize.

(Jack is active making orders to built fire, Ralph is motionless).

Soon they seat around the fire.

Where did you find the pig?

They were there by the sea.

Jack.

We spread round. I crept on hands and knees.

(one boy makes a pig). The pig ran away and made an awful noise.

It turned back and ran into the icicle. We closed in...

(cover the boy with a blanket as if they kill him).

'Kill the pig. Cut her throat. Spill her blood.'

(The boys dance round the fire)

Ralph

(watches them enviously)

I'm calling an assembly.

(one by one the boys halted)

With the conch. I'm calling a meeting. Down on the platform. When I blow it.

Now.

(He turns away and walked off, down the mountain).

"Ralf turned to the chief's seat. They had never had an assembly as late before. That was why the place looked so different.

Again he fell into that strange mood of speculation that was so foreign to him. Ralph moved impatiently. The trouble was, if you were a chief you had to think, you had to be wise. And then the occasion slipped by so that you had to grab at a decision. This made you think; because thought was a valuable thing that got results... Ralph was a specialist in thought now, and could recognize thought in another.

He faced the place of assembly and put the conch to his lips. The others were waiting for this and came straight away.

Those who were aware that the ship had passed the island while the fire was out were subdued by the thought of Ralph's anger; while others, who didn't know, were impressed by the general air of solemnity. 'The thing is: we need an assembly.' No one said anything but the faces turned to Ralph were intent. He had learnt a practical business that fundamental statements like this had to be said at least twice, before everyone understood them.

‘We have lots of assemblies. Everyone enjoys speaking and being together. We decide things. But they don’t get done. And then, about the fire...

The fire is the most important thing on the island. How can we ever be rescued except by luck, if we don’t keep the fire going? Is a fire too much for us? Look at us! How many are we?
